

## Abstract

The right of admission into a local governing body for females has started since 1982. Later, they were elected and promoted to take over a large number of local political leaders. The studies, thus, need to find out characters and problems of such communities and the way to promote the status of female correctly and extensively.

A conceptual framework of the research is political communication. All samples are taken from members of all local administration councils whose chairman was a female during 1983 - 1986

The findings : Female - leader communities usually have low socio-economic status, sex discrimination, quite modern political cosmology and quite modern communication process. Consequently, the problem of female consent occurs due to the fact that a female leader is neither a creative, an influential, nor a credible source. A mix of various patterns in transitional societies is established in political communication which a well-educated authoritarian leader makes a reasonable decision, Furthermore, communication process is the most significant factor, (compared to political behavior and sex status) of discrimination and modernity of communities.
